Dear Mr. Brown,

On November 14th and 15th we are having our 10th annual state championships for youth football. Our league is based here in Nlr with the Police Athletic League and Oak Grove Youth Football being the charter members. Our teams are full of NLR kids from 5-12 years old who will participate again in a joint effort to win the state championship as we did last year. Our event takes 8 fields over 2 day period to complete with 72 teams coming to the greater Nlr area to participate. We have held part of it here on the old field in the past to give our kids a chance to showcase their community to others around the state and beyond. We are using Hendrix College, UCA, Maumelle High School, Sylvan Hills High, Little Rock Mills, Cabot High,C.W. .Lewis in Benton this year. We ask for your permission to use the Nlr football Field on Saturday from 8am to 7pm and Sunday from 8 till 3pm to allow our league kids from Nlr to play at home. We charge admission for the first few teams coming in to pay referee fees, clean up and pay certification workers . Both clubs are non profit 501c3 and reinvest any left over back into the clubs for equipment , training etc. Anyone that has been at another park gets in free that day at any other park. This explains why the admission fee doesn't go too far in collecting each day. The schools rosters are full of players over the last 10 years who played for us and our goal playing the games has been to expose our players to a variety of talent from elsewhere. We are showing the benefits of this as we have won a divisions title the last 4 years after never winning one the first 5. Nlr Pal and Ogyfa both let kids who couldn,t afford to play do so for free which keeps them off the streets and learning teamwork. This year the 5th grade team we want to feature is coached by Kenny McMahan and Jay Amberg from Nlr Pal with several OG players joining his roster as a joint effort to beat out 15 other teams as the best. We pray you might allow us to do this at your facility to show off where the kids are from and not have to play their games at Cabot. Thank You for considering
