The retirement of Michael "Rusty" Arnold as of December 31, 2010, was approved on a motion by Mildred Green with a second by Danny Watson. Motion carried 7-0.

The board voted to employ Dee Cox as a consultant for School Improvement on a motion by Janice Milus with a second by Denny Dickinson. Motion carried 7-0.

The retirement of Janey Wray as of January 31, 2011, was approved on a motion by Mildred Green with a second by Denny Dickinson. Motion carried 7-0.

On a motion by Willie Buck with a second by Danny Watson, the hourly wage of all after school duties other than tutoring was increased by \$5 per hour for certified and \$2.50 for classified. Motion carried 7-0.
