- Dr. Brooksher welcomed Debi McNeal to Richmond Hill High School as the new principal. He thanked the community and the staff that participated in the Bryan County Schools school calendar survey. There were over 1,590 responses. He stated the school system is still growing. We had 8,000 students in October, which included prekindergarten. As of today, the total is 8,036. This is illustrative of which direction we will continue to go.
  - B. Richmond Hill Primary School Activities Mary Ann Tiedemann

Principal Mary Anne Tiedemann welcomed the Board to Richmond Hill Primary School. She was happy to see Marianne Smith serving on the Board. In the past she had served on the school council. She said Richmond Hill Primary School is very proud of the number of volunteers it has. In one weeks time they have 178 parent volunteers. They also have 26 early childcare education students from Richmond Hill High School and 9 students from Armstrong Atlantic University.

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The leadership team at the school started a new project called Math Magic. Every Friday two students from each class meet in the cafeteria. They have around the world flashcard drills. The winners receive a t-shirt and have their names announced over the intercom. For the past seven years, the school has held a Father-Daughter dance. She shared a video of the dance. The leadership team also came up with a way to spark interest in science. Students were asked to think of a problem that could help to make things easier and better. The student and parent would build the invention and share it with the school. She shared a movie of the students interviewing each other regarding the inventions. The inventions were on display in the media center.

Dr. Brooksher stated he is working on the budget cycle. He will be meeting with principals and department heads. There will be training opportunities for the departments regarding preparing a budget for the particular department.

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Dennis Seger asked that the architect be invited to the next workshop. Eddie Warren stated they have said they will come when we need them to. They will also give a report at each Board meeting. He or Dr. Brooksher will call the architect.

Amy Murphy asked if we can make every effort so kids will not be crossing the street to get on the bus. Dr. Brooksher stated he plans to have a summer meeting with law enforcement officials. Transportation will also be working on the routes.

### B. Approve a Resolution to Approve Local Facilities Plan (Attachment #3)

Dr. Brooksher stated he had sent the Board an email trying to summarize the process. Every five years the system goes through a facilities review that is required by the state. The only modification to ours was getting the South Richmond Hill Elementary School site on our plan. Once the board approves it, we have to send it to the state to request funding. Amy Murphy made a motion to approve. Joe Pecenka seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously. Dr. Brooksher stated the Facilities Team commended the board for its foresight in preparing for growth in the South Bryan area. The team believes in moving it to a K-5 configuration applies for more efficient services as well as in the long run proves to be a good decision.

C. Authorize the board chairman and the superintendent to negotiate and enter into agreement(s) with Thomas & Hutton Engineering Company for future capital projects

David Schwartz made a motion to approve. Amy Murphy seconded the motion. Joe Pecenka asked if we have a final agreement ready to sign. Eddie Warren stated yes that Dr. Brooksher has three copies. He said Ralph Forbes is here if anyone has any specific questions. He stated he has been negotiating with Mr. Forbes and believes it is a good deal. He said Thomas & Hutton has also offered to donate their services for the landscaping design which was on both facilities. Joe Pecenka thanked Mr. Forbes for working with the board on that and helping the board to structure it where it is in the best interest of the board and the county. Mr. Forbes stated we appreciate the opportunity. He stated he lives here and takes everything we do with heavy heart. We are going to do the best job we can and look forward to finally getting to work with the school board. Eddie Warren stated the contract is a not-to-exceed contract. It also states if some projects do not cost that much then we don't have to pay that.

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Eddie Warren said that if the board votes to do this, surveying will start on Tuesday on both school sites. The motion carried unanimously.

### D. South Bryan Elementary School Well Discussion

Dr. Brooksher gave the board a hard copy of what is being discussed. Eddie Warren stated that basically they took the total consumption that the board would be using (most being the fire suppression that we are required to have and the county is not required to have) which would be 60.2%, BLT would be 37.5%, and the county administration would be 2.3%. That comes out that our share is our tap fee for water. The bid on the well was \$620,000. There is talk the price could be lower. Mr. Warren said he is suggesting the board goes ahead and votes to have the board chairman and the county board chairman enter into an agreement and also sit down week after next with all parties and talk about what can and can't be cut down. The developer has proposed that (his share is 37.5%) he would pay 50% which would save us \$70,000. The county now says that he cannot do that. There are some recoup and tap fees. Mr. Warren stated the board could table this and amend the agenda after executive session if Ray has any answers. Joe Pecenka stated he would like to move on from this topic.

There is no spot for action at this time. He said the agenda could be amended after executive session.

#### AT RICHMOND HILL PREKINDERGARTEN CENTER

The Bryan County Board of Education met on Thursday, September 19, 2013, at 6:00 p.m., at the Richmond Hill Prekindergarten Center for a called board work session.

#### I. CALL TO ORDER – Eddie Warren

Board Chairman Eddie Warren called the meeting to order. Members present were: Eddie Warren, Dennis Seger, Joe Pecenka, Amy Murphy, and Paine Bacon. David Schwartz and Marianne Smith were absent.

#### II. ADOPTION OF AGENDA – Eddie Warren

- C. Melanie James shared a summary of school student activity accounts as requested by the board chairman.
- D. Dr. Trey Robertson stated that Savannah/Chatham has adjusted its school calendar and has booked the Civic Center the same week we would need it for graduation. We need an alternate for the Richmond Hill High School graduation. After discussing, the board asked that he contact Savannah State University. If that does not work two other alternates were suggested Savannah International Trade Center and Armstrong Atlantic State University.
- E. Dr. Brooksher stated that in the past the board chairman has attended a meeting with the auditor. Three board members may attend. He does not have a date yet but as soon as he does, he would like to invite three board members to attend this year.

#### IV. CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATES AND DISCUSSION

- Dr. Trey Robertson and Construction Manager Bill Vickery reported on the following:
- A. Security Quotes Due to entry access concerns around the country, the board had asked about making our facilities more secure with controlled entry access. After discussion, the board members stated they would like for all schools to be retrofitted at the same time. Mr. Vickery will bring more information to the board meeting next week.

- B. Mr. Vickery gave an update on the Bryan County High School field house that is under construction.
- C. Dr. Robertson stated he has started an athletic committee. They will look at many aspects of improving athletics.
- D. Dr. Robertson recommended that the school system place its name on the 1-800-CALL-DIG list.
- E. Dr. Robertson stated that the punch list for Richmond Hill Middle School is much smaller. The architect has been meeting with the new contractor and giving him updates when things will be completed.
- F. Dr. Brooksher asked the board about names for the plaque to be placed at Richmond Hill Middle School. It was a consensus to place the board member names on it that were on the board when it opened.
- G. Dr. Brooksher stated that the Board of Education has received school bus bond funds from the state department for buses. At the September 26<sup>th</sup> board meeting, he will request that the board approve purchasing two buses.
- H. At the September 26<sup>th</sup> board meeting, Dr. Brooksher will request that the board authorize the Board chairman and the Superintendent to sign an easement agreement with Georgia Power regarding Payne Drive.
- I. Dr. Brooksher stated that the Capital Outlay Application was approved at the July 27<sup>th</sup> board meeting. The projected start date to break ground for McAllister Elementary School will be January, 2014. Paperwork for Bryan County Elementary School had not come back as of today.

They want to know what the Board is supposed to be doing and what the schools are supposed to be doing. We need to look at the content as not only what we are dealing with today and who are administrators are but look at the future too. He said he has a lot of concerns that he wants to ask about before making a recommendation.

# I. CALL TO ORDER – Eddie Warren

Board Chairman Eddie Warren called the meeting to order. Members present were: Paine Bacon, Amy Murphy, Joe Pecenka, David Schwartz, Dennis Seger, and Eddie Warren.

# MINUTES FOR BRYAN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION CALLED WORK SESSION HELD ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2013 AT 6:00 P. M. AT BRYAN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Bryan County Board of Education met on Thursday, October 17, 2013, at 6:00 p.m., at the Central Office.

### I. CALL TO ORDER – Eddie Warren

Board Chairman Eddie Warren called the meeting to order. Members present were: Paine Bacon, Amy Murphy, Joe Pecenka, David Schwartz, Dennis Seger, Marianne Smith, and Eddie Warren.

### II. ADOPTION OF AGENDA – Eddie Warren

Joe Pecenka made a motion to amend the agenda to change Item VII. Executive Session from Personnel to Personnel/Land Acquisition. Dennis Seger seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Dennis Seger made a motion to approve the agenda as corrected. Amy Murphy seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

### III. SUPERINTENDENT UPDATES

### Strategic Planning

Dr. Brooksher stated this was talked about at the last work session. He shared an anticipated timeline for planning. He wants to get input from stakeholders and bring a final draft back to the board in February. He would also discuss it with the board at every work session prior to February. He stated the board would be involved, his citizen's advisory committee (CAC), his teacher advisory committee (TAC), and central office leadership. They would take it to their departments to get feedback. This project would be similar to the vision and mission team effort. The feedback was good with those. His goal is to come up with a meaningful document. Joe Pecenka asked if this strategic plan will be incorporated into his evaluation document or not. Dr. Brooksher stated it is usually more the big picture plan for the district. Dennis Seger asked who is on the TAC and CAC. Dr. Brooksher stated that the TAC is composed of the teachers of the year. The schools ask for volunteers for the CAC. Mr. Seger asked that Dr. Brooksher furnish the board with a list of members for the CAC. Dr. Brooksher then shared a list of short-term and long-term commitment statements to Bryan County Schools. He said the Board might want to pair this with the evaluation that Amy Murphy found. Paine Bacon asked when the Board was going to do that. Eddie Warren stated he plans to put together a committee for that. Amy Murphy and Marianne Smith volunteered to be on the committee with Mr. Warren.

### RHHS Graduation Site

Dr. Trey Robertson stated Richmond Hill High School had put out a survey for students and parents in regards to choices of sites for the RHHS graduation. Savannah State was the winner. The Board agreed on this.

Dr. Robertson shared information about needing a new engine for a special education bus. After much discussion, Dr. Brooksher suggested we work on getting more detailed information to the board.

Dr. Robertson informed the board that Richmond Hill High School west gym needs new wrestling mats. The mats that were there were ruined when it flooded over the summer. The Board discussed splitting the cost with the high school. The Board also asked that he have someone look at what it would take to repair the flooded area. Dr. Robertson stated he would get Bill Vickery to look at it.

### AdvancED Accreditation

Dr. Anderson shared about accreditation. He said he is setting up committees for each standard. He also would like Board members on the committees. He gave each Board member a form to check a box showing which committee he/she would be interested in being a part of.

# Technology Infrastructure

Dr. Robertson shared that it will be time to renew the filter license at the end of this month at a cost of \$26,000. The filter protects email. We are in the process of restructuring our infrastructure. We need to be able to increase our bandwidth. Initially the state had planned to fund everyone in the state at one time. That fell through. We can apply for a grant by December 31 to get us started with the firewall and filter system.

# Capital Projects

Dr. Robertson shared a modified punch list for Richmond Hill Middle School.

The plaque for Richmond Hill Middle School was discussed again.

Signs for Richmond Hill Middle School were also discussed. Eddie Warren stated someone needs to check the contract on the property before placing signs. It was noted that Richmond Hill Middle School PTSO is giving \$8000 toward a sign.

# Field House Ribbon Cutting

Dr. Robertson stated that he found out today that the flooring will not be in until next Tuesday. After discussion, the Board requested that the ribbon cutting be moved from Friday, October 18 until Friday, November 8, at 5:30 p.m.

Dr. Robertson shared that the Board needs to purchase weights for the field house and the weight room. He will ask for three or four quotes.

# IV. ADMINISTRATION

A. Authorize the board chairman and superintendent to sign a right of way quitclaim deed giving Warren Hill Road to the Bryan County Board of Commissioners

Amy Murphy made a motion to approve. David Schwartz seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

### VI. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS/NEW BUSINESS

Dennis Seger thanked Carole Knight and Dr. Brooksher for the meal. He thanked Dr. Robertson for his hard work. He asked that someone explain to him about so many meetings that administrators have to attend. He feels they need to be more visible in the schools. He stated a lot of people do not see the Superintendent or the administrators at the schools. He asked that if a principal is out of a building to allow the assistant principal to make a decision. If he/she makes a wrong decision, it can be corrected later. Dr. Brooksher stated you are not going to have systemic improvement unless you meet, discuss, and have professional development for folks. He stated he does have required meetings for the principals once a month. He said they also have to attend other meetings. He stated he tries to balance meetings so that the principal and assistant principal are not out of the building at the same time. Sometimes, they are both out. He stated there is a lot of support in a school building. He said his meetings are very prescribed meetings. We have a lot going on in this organization. He also has training meetings with nurses and counselors. Mr. Seger asked that he spend more time in the schools and classrooms. Dr. Brooksher stated he does visit schools and he is committed to do more visiting.

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Eddie Warren stated there is an Inforum in Ware County on October 29. He plans to go. If anyone else wants to go, they are to let him know.

Mr. Warren stated the Board needs to appoint a legislative liaison and alternate. Joe Pecenka stated he would do it and Mr. Warren stated he would be the alternate. This item will be on the October 24 board agenda for approval.

Mr. Warren stated he sent an email to the Board regarding representing GSBA on the Federal Relations Network in February. This item will be on the October 24 board agenda for approval.

Mr. Warren shared he attended a GSBA Board Chairman Advisory Committee meeting yesterday. It was one of the best he has ever been to in the four years he has attended. He stated that fifteen board chairmen were invited to that. It was very beneficial. He said as discussions came up, he felt very lucky to be in Bryan County. We have not had to give up things like other school systems have had to do.

Mr. Warren stated he is in touch with Savannah Tech to set up a meeting on the campus in Liberty County. He wants to look at a partnership with them to come into our system. He is also getting in touch with the president of Armstrong.

He gave kudos to the Board on the work they have done lately. He received a call from Rayonier yesterday. We worked with them and Terrapointe on the land for the middle school. They are extremely happy with what we have done with the property and building and what it looks like. They have asked Mr. Warren to host a board chairman, a superintendent, and a facilities director from Nassau County who Rayonier is working with on another development. They want them to come see the building and for Rayonier to be able to tell them this is what Rayonier wants on the land they are working on. He does not have all of the details yet.

Marianne Smith reminded the Board about Career Day at Bryan County Middle School on Friday, October 25, at 8:30 a.m.

Joe Pecenka asked Mr. Warren and Dr. Brooksher about the community planning retreat. Dr. Brooksher stated it was beneficial. He said from an educational standpoint, he did learn we need to do a better job of educating our public. There is a lot of misinformation of what we don't offer or do offer. He said it was neat to see all of the leaders of the county come together. Eddie Warren stated he did not believe it was as productive as 2010 was. He said it was great to see everyone come together. He stated there needs to be more follow-up. Dr. Brooksher stated it was a good opportunity to talk about districting, SPLOST, and budgets.

# Early Release Data

Dr. Brooksher shared data regarding the first early release for parent/teacher conferences. Overall, he felt it went very well.

### Title I Distinguished District Award

Dr. Anderson shared that on the November 6 State Board agenda was information stating that Bryan County is one of four districts in the state that will receive Title I Distinguished District Award. The Title I Schools will receive an

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additional \$50,000 to further their work. Dr. Anderson will work with the schools on how it can be spent. Dr. Brooksher should be receiving a letter regarding this information.

# Strategic Planning

Dr. Brooksher stated that the Board started talking at the last work session regarding a five-year strategic plan. He gave each board member a note card to write down what he/she felt are going to be the five biggest challenges for the school system over the next five years. He shared that he has already started gathering information from the principals, assistant principals, central office administrators and staff, the teachers' advisory committee, the citizens' advisory committee, and from each school. All of this information will be compiled on a spreadsheet. He will then bring back to the board the top ten priorities.

Dr. Brooksher shared a bestselling book by Diane Ravitch titled "The Death and Life of the Great American School System".

  Erin Turner, RHHS
- Dr. Brooksher introduced Erin Turner, RHHS, as the System Teacher of the Year. He and Ms. McNeal shared comments about Ms. Turner. Dr. Brooksher presented her with an award, a check, and a market tote full of supplies.
- Dr. Brooksher stated we have a surprise that is not on the agenda because the folks doing it wanted it to be a surprise. Jessica Bosworth along with an intern, Katie, said this is their third annual giving of an award in honor of school psychology awareness week. They want to raise awareness about their profession. They honor people who are promoting positive outcome for students. They presented certificates to Kathy Browne and Erica Birchall.

### B. Richmond Hill High School Activities – Debi McNeal

Ms. McNeal stated that we had heard the band and chorus before the meeting and had seen displays from the CTAE classes and the visual arts classes. She stated she wanted to highlight Pathways. Ms. McNeal shared a video highlighting various Pathways. She stated two courses were added this year – graphic arts and broadcast video. She introduced Kay Green from the South Bryan Recreation Department who was there to make a presentation to some graphic art students. She also introduced the visual arts teacher, Mrs. Yvette Crow. Mrs. Crow stated she teaches graphic designs and decided to take on a local project this year with the Recreation Department. It was a logo design competition. She stated the students did a fantastic job. She had ninety-nine students who did designs. They narrowed the designs down to twenty-five to give to Mrs. Green to pick from. Three students were winners out of the twentyfive entry submissions from RHHS. Mrs. Green gave a \$25 check and a t-shirt with his design printed on it to Juan Cruz who came in third place. The second place winner was Alexis Arai. She received a check for \$50 and a t-shirt with her design printed on it. The first place winner was Trey McGuire. He had completed two logos. The second design was chosen for first place. Mrs. Green stated that they have put the logo on their letterhead and basketball uniform. Trey received t-shirts with both of his designs on them and a check for \$100.

Dr. Brooksher stated we have one more surprise. He shared how Kristi Cox of United Way had invited him to a luncheon and insisted he be there. He asked that Mrs. Cox come up and share the rest of the story. Mrs. Cox shared that once there, Dr. Brooksher received an award that had been created just for the Bryan County School System. It was called the Herschel V. Jenkins Award. It is not to be given on an annual basis. The school system raised its contributions from last year by 149% contributing \$27,792.85. It is the highest amount ever given by any organization in Bryan County. She stated that she attended a principals' luncheon and presented Bryan County Middle School a trophy for increasing their giving's by 810% over last year. The caring cup was presented to Richmond Hill High School for contributing \$9,683.72.

### C. Strategic Planning

Dr. Brooksher shared the top 10 things that school system folks believe will be the biggest challenges for the next 5 years. He received over 1500 comments. He asked the board to look at the 10 and assist in narrowing it to 5. He said Mrs. Murphy mentioned at the last board meeting about surveying the

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community. He would like to prioritize the top five and then take it to the public. He asked the board to take a few minutes to look at it. The board asked if he would send it to them electronically to do or they would do this later in the meeting.

Dr. Brooksher stated that he told Dennis Seger he would bring salary information on classified employees to the January board meeting. He shared a form that Mary Beth Brothers had produced on salary comparison for school nurses based on school districts in our region. He wanted the Board to tell him if the format is easy to read before he goes further with this request. The Board agreed the format is fine. He stated he will do a formal presentation at the January work session. He said it will be a busy session. Eddie Warren stated that just so everyone knows, there may be two work sessions.

Dr. Brooksher also shared dates that the Advanced Ed committee would like to meet one-on-one with Board members as we work on obtaining district accreditation. The dates are Monday, March 24 and Wednesday, March 26. He stated three people are from Georgia and two are from Florida. He also stated in January there would be a Standard 2 discussion. He will also work on a fact sheet about the district so everyone can be as prepared as they can be.

### D. Capital Projects

Dr. Trey Robertson stated he has a couple of major capital projects. (1) He sent emails regarding Richmond Hill Middle School change Order #1 and #2. He asked if the Board had any questions about either of these. Joe Pecenka asked if he would do a quick review for the Board. Dr. Robertson said Change Order #1 is from early on in the project for \$153,000. \$120,000 deals with power to the school. Apparently, there was an issue with getting power to the building and going through wetlands. The Board had to pay for generators and fuel. He believes from the notes he has that this was discussed with the Board at some point but was never brought forth. The Board was also upset because it had to pay \$46,000 in builders risk insurance bonds that Hensler and Beaver could not. He is bringing it to the Board so it can be taken care of before we finalize. With Change Order #2, the system will receive a \$90,000 credit. We have come to a good spot we feel we have received our monies worth. They have repaired what they needed to at Richmond Hill Middle School. Once these change orders are approved tonight, we have paperwork to fill out and we can then draw down \$230,000 the state owes us. We can also pay a little more than a million to Hartford. Dennis Seger asked if the change orders are approved tonight, can we close out Richmond Hill Middle School. Dr. Robertson said yes.

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(2) The second capital project deals with Richmond Hill Middle School football field area. The Board had set money aside to deal with the field because there are issues with it. The bleachers are inadequate and fans cannot get to the bleachers unless they cross a ravine. There is plywood on the ground and there are also pipes sticking up on the edge of the field. Five hundred seats have been proposed so we can take about six games a year off the high school field. He gave the Board a copy of the proposal in the amount of \$118,000. Eddie Warren asked Dr. McGrath how many fans come per game. Dr. McGrath stated they have about 200-400 fans per game. Mr. Warren asked him to get the documents for the Board showing that information and the gate receipts. Dr. Robertson said all of the seats will be on one side. They are not going to be split up as the area is not big enough. Fencing also needs to be moved and grading needs to be done. Dennis Seger said he thinks the fields at Bryan County High School were poor design from the engineer and the contractor. He said this all needs to be corrected. Dr. Robertson stated this will help lessen traffic on the high school field. He asked that the Board look at the proposal and talk about it in January.

Dr. Robertson stated that Bill Vickery is here to answer questions about the proposed added alternates for the new schools that Dr. Robertson sent in an email to the board. Dr. Brooksher said he is also the person that brought the proposal about the football fields at RHMS and can answer any questions. Dr. Robertson reminded the board that a decision will not be made until we actually get numbers. We should get those in mid-March on McAllister and late March on the new BCES. He said the Board will get to look at options. They will also look at long-term versus short-term items. Dennis Seger asked that Mr. Vickery explain them to the Board. Eddie Warren said what they are doing is asking if there are any other ideas or thoughts the Board has that they should make as an option. We will not know the price on them yet. They will bid them two ways, we can see the prices and pick what we want. Dr. Robertson said once the prices come in, we will get Mr. Vickery to set a time to answer any questions about all those alternates or anything else you all want to add or think we need to consider as analternate. Mr. Warren stated he had a question about the awnings on the front of the building where the metal roofs are on top. There are two that run down to nothing. He asked why do we have them and what is the cost for one of those structures. Mr. Vickery stated we have the alternate to delete portions of that canopy. He felt the architect put them in because you have a lot of people at the building; you can unload at the entire front. Mr. Warren agreed the distance is not bad. He asked what the average cost would be and Mr. Vickery stated \$26,000. Mr. Vickery reminded the Board that the list they put out there is not a

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set-in-stone list. It is a list he does up front. You can't put a job with this size scope out with 500 different items. They will get confused. He said let us do a base bid right and a few major items for you to make a clear economic decision on. After that we will go deeper - that is called value engineering. He said he will give the Board clear ramifications, recovery cost and maintenance cost for each of the items.

Eddie Warren asked a question about the lights. He saw two different types and the repayment was seven years. Mr. Vickery said he did not put that in there. His study showed 19 years for the energy cost savings.

Dennis Seger asked a question on the proposal to relocate the fence at RHMS football field and add a four foot fence. He wanted to know the reason for relocating it and going with four foot. Mr. Vickery said if you install bleachers, it will keep the patrons off the field and keep the football players out of the bleachers. He also said there are two water pumps less than ten feet off the field that someone could get hurt on. He said the four foot fence would be just in front of the bleachers. Dennis Seger asked what general conditions are? Mr. Vickery said general conditions is builders risk insurance, insurance and supervision. He said there are also sidewalks that need to be installed. Eddie Warren asked if he would get the Board a drawing of what all of this would look like.

Mr. Vickery stated the security doors are going well.YKK shut down their plant for a couple of days so he cannot start the project until January 3. They will do Lanier Primary School first. It will take two or three weekends. They cannot complete the job 100% before the winter break is over.

Joe Pecenka said he wanted to go back to the fields because he has a question. He wanted to know if there is a rule about having to have so many seats. Dr. Robertson stated there are no rules for middle school. They do not have to follow Georgia High School Association standards.

Dennis Seger asked if anyone has looked at the fields here at Richmond Hill High School. Eddie Warren stated that by next season they need to be graded. Dr. Robertson said they have been laser graded before. The problem is the drainage. He stated if you want a permanent fix, it will cost more than \$15,000 - \$20,000. He said he can do an RFP and have people propose prices. He said it will probably be \$100,000 or more. He said doing a quick fix by laser grading will help but in two or three years, it will be needed again. Joe Pecenka asked if Mr. Vickery could get us a ball park figure. Mr. Vickery explained what all would need to be done. He said he would need  $3 - \frac{1}{2}$  months to complete the job

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which would include sidewalks that are needed. Mickey Bayens stated they could use the recreation department fields while this is going on. Dennis Seger asked that Mr. Vickery work up an estimate by the January meeting.

Dennis Seger asked Dr. Robertson about the lights for the parking lots. Dr. Robertson said he has a proposal from Georgia Power for Carver Elementary. They plan to put wall packs on the backside of Carver to see how that works. He has not heard from Georgia Power on Bryan County Middle School. Canoochee Electric chose not to give a quote. He said he did send an RFP for electrical service at both elementary schools. Coastal Electric will have McAllister. Georgia Power did not bid. He is not sure about North Bryan yet. Canoochee did bid. He is looking at Georgia Power proposals now.

Amy Murphy thanked Mr. Vickery for the ham he gave the Board members.
