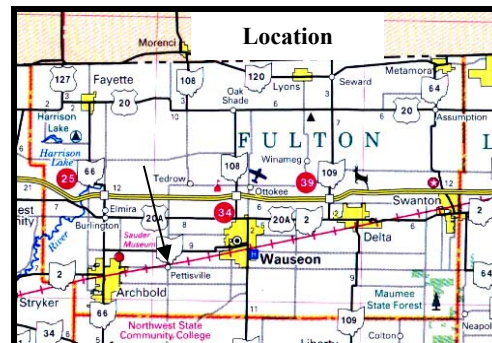

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The Pettisville Local Schools, located in Fulton County, Ohio, 30 miles west of Toledo, is a unique school district in terms of Ohio education today. One of the smallest districts in the state, Pettisville enjoys an almost unduplicated level of public support.

- A “School of Choice” Pettisville ranks in the top ten in the state in percentage (40%) of incoming open enrollment students.
- **Pettisville High School was one of 38 public high schools in the nation named a “Federal Blue Ribbon” school for 2005.**



- **The district received the “Excellent” ranking in eleven of the last twelve years the ranking was awarded.**
- Opened new PK-12 facility in 2011
 - 250 seat theatre expandable to 650
 - Student union type Atrium
 - Two gyms seating 1,200 and 1,300
 - CareerTech Ag facility & greenhouse
 - Daylighted high school classrooms
 - Wi Fi available throughout
 - Geothermal heating and cooling
 - Solar water pre-heating
 - Powered by 750 kW turbine
 - LEED Gold Rated
 - Project 2 million under budget
- **Compared with 610 districts statewide ... Performance Index-Overall Academic Rank**
 - 2013-14—107.2 Ranked 49th

- 2012-13—106.3 Ranked 57th
- Ranked first in four county area in PI for last nine of ten years

- The *Pettisville School Foundation* has donated over \$3,000,000 including the 1994 Capital Drive Addition, of gym, library, classrooms & offices.
- **In 2012 PSF constructed a \$900,000 Atrium joining the buildings and creating a “student union” type atmosphere.**
- Wind Powered Electricity is provided by a district owned 1.9 million dollar Aeronautica 750 kW turbine.



- **Pettisville Elementary was named a “School of Distinction” in 2006.**
- The Agriculture program was named “2003 Outstanding Program in the State”.
- **Ag instructor John Poulson was named National Agri-science Teacher of the Year Region IV (of 6 nationwide) in 2016.**
- “FFA Alumni and Friends,” with 150 members is second largest chapter in Ohio.
- **Recent Drama Department productions include “Fiddler on the Roof,” “Joseph,” and “South Pacific.”**
- The Music Boosters annually donate over \$25,000 to many school organizations.

- **2015 & 2016 Silver Medalist in U.S. News & World Report’s high school ranking.**



- In 2013 received LEED GOLD rating for new school building.
- **Buckeye Border All-Sports Champ in 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016.**
- The Blackbirds won or shared eight consecutive BBC Championships in boys’ basketball from 2003 to 2010.
- **Former State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Dr. Susan Zelman, described Pettisville as “the school I would like my grandchildren to attend.”**
- Since 1944, 18 of 19 new tax issues have been approved on the first attempt.
- **The Meister Endowment Fund, created by a bequest in 1982, has a value of more than \$160,000 and is used for special projects.**
- Since centralization in 1929 district has had:
 - 48 board of ed members (9.5 yrs avg)
 - 7 superintendents (12 year average)
 - 7 high school principals (12 yr avg)
- **In 2013 & 2014 received an “A” in “Annual Measurable Objectives”, one of 27/28 earned statewide.**
