## Cambridge High School 2015 ACT Top 4% In Wisconsin

Cambridge High School students who took the ACT college entrance exam in 2014-15 had the highest composite average in Jefferson County and the Capital Conference Schools.

The district's composite score was 24.3 was also the third highest in Dane County and 16th-highest in Wisconsin.

The state average composite score was 22.2 out of 36 for the second straight year. Wisconsin and Iowa tied for second behind Minnesota (22.7). The national average was 21.0.
