

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The superintendent of Amber-Pocasset School District will be responsible for the implementation of all curricular activities and shall organize a continuous study of educational materials and procedures in order that justifiable changes might be made. The curriculum shall be changed as the needs and interests of the pupils change and shall not be static, but a program of continuous growth. Additions to the curriculum will be approved by the board of education upon the recommendations of the administrative personnel and the instructional staff.

The Amber-Pocasset Board of Education believes strongly that quality curriculum should be accessible to every student. The board further believes that the curriculum should also translate the school's statement of philosophy and goals into learning objectives and activities and that the curriculum should be designed to prepare all students for employment and/or post-secondary education.

The superintendent and, under the superintendent's authority, the directors of curriculum will be responsible for the development, supervision and evaluation of the curriculum.

The directors of curriculum will organize departmental committees to assist in conducting a continuous study of educational materials and procedures in order that justifiable changes might be made.

The curriculum may be changed as the needs and interests of the community change, and will not be static.

Additions or changes in the curriculum will be considered by the board after being recommended through established administrative channels. All available curriculum guides and materials will be made available to the parents of children who will be taught in those programs.
